



What is Rotary Leadership Circle?

Rotary Leadership Circle (RLC) is a six-week program for youth hosted July 5 - August 13, 2021. Youth Agencies Alliance (YAA) facilitates the program as a summer work project which promotes community engagement and skill-building for youth. RLC provides youth with the opportunity to learn life skills in a supportive environment, interact with role models, and positively contribute to their communities.

Youth aged 10 - 14 are eligible to apply for the program as RLC Youth Leaders. During RLC, youth participate in planned activities for a minimum of 60 hours (approximately 10 hours per week) throughout the summer. A \$200.00 stipend to spend on a supervised shopping experience will be awarded to youth if all hours are fulfilled. Youth participants must be available for all six-weeks of the program to be considered.

This year, the activities will include hybrid formats of in-person* and virtual experiences. Youth will also participate in program evaluations to reflect on their skills, behaviors, and program satisfaction. All information obtained will be without full names, kept confidential, and held securely by YAA in their online database (Hello Insight).
